

Move RM7 Place Detail data to Description – Instructions for FTM users

Step 1 – import FTM native database to RM7 using RM 7.1.0.7 or later

Step 2 – Install SQLite Expert Personal 3. Get it from here:

Step 3 – Install RMNOCASE extension to SQLite Expert. Get it from here:

<http://sqlitetoolsforrootsmagic.wikispaces.com/RMNOCASE+-+faking+it+in+SQLite+Expert%2C+command-line+shell+et+al>

Download and save to the same folder where you have the executable file for SQLite.

On my Windows 7 64-bit Professional PC, the directory is called:

C:\Program Files (x86)\SQLite Expert\Personal 3

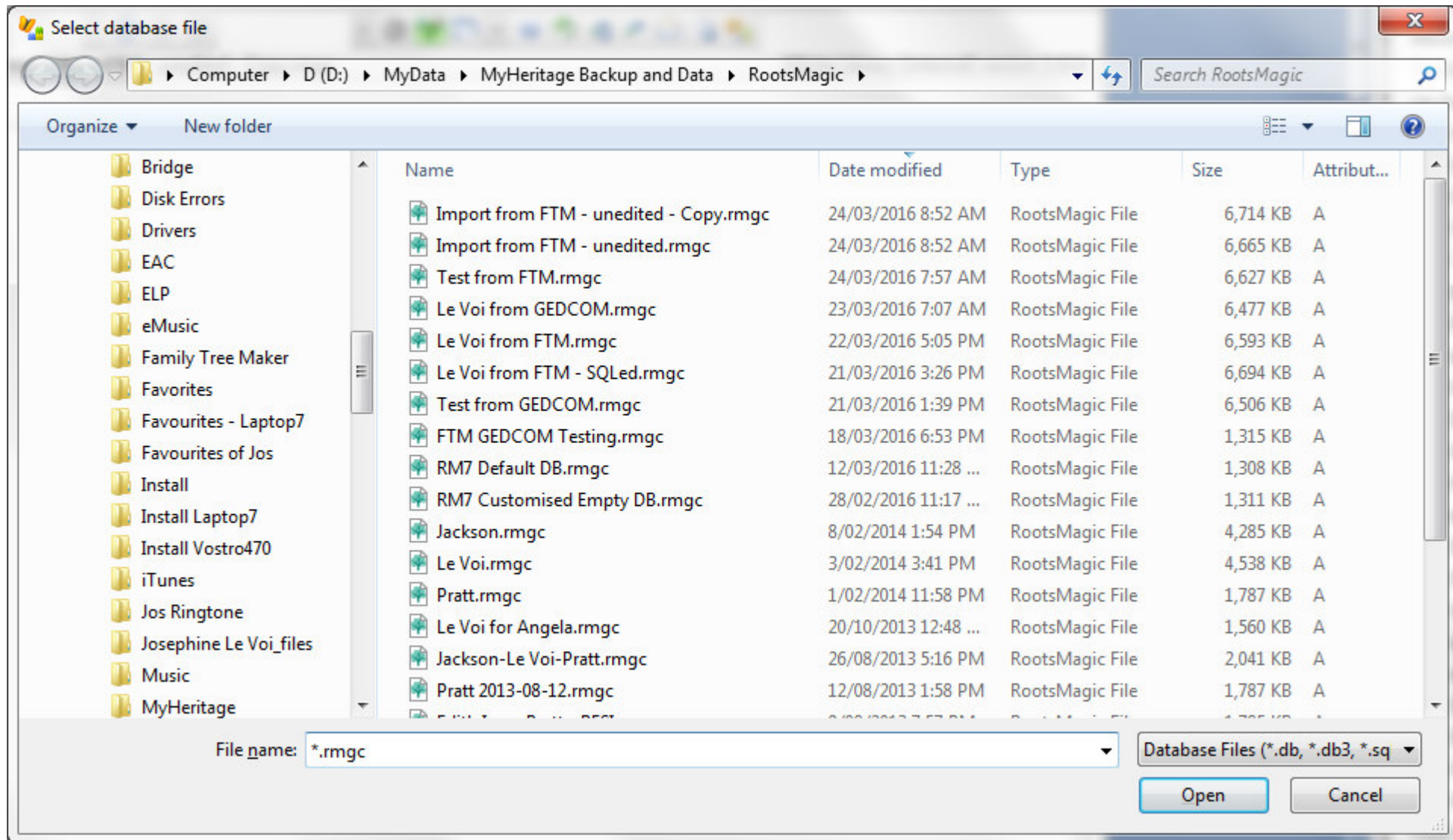
To copy the unifuzz.dll file to this directory, Windows will ask for Administrator permission. This is normal.

Step 4 – Run SQLite Expert

Step 5 – Open the RM7 database

I suggest that you use Windows to copy/paste the real database to a COPY before you try this. You can always repeat the SQL on the real database later.

File > Open Database. Change the “File Name:” to “*.rmgc” and hit Enter so you can see all the .rmgc files. Select the database and click Open.



Step 6 – Look at some Place Detail data (Optional)

Click on PlaceTable. Look at the Data tab. Scroll to the bottom of the list. These are the Place Details 😊

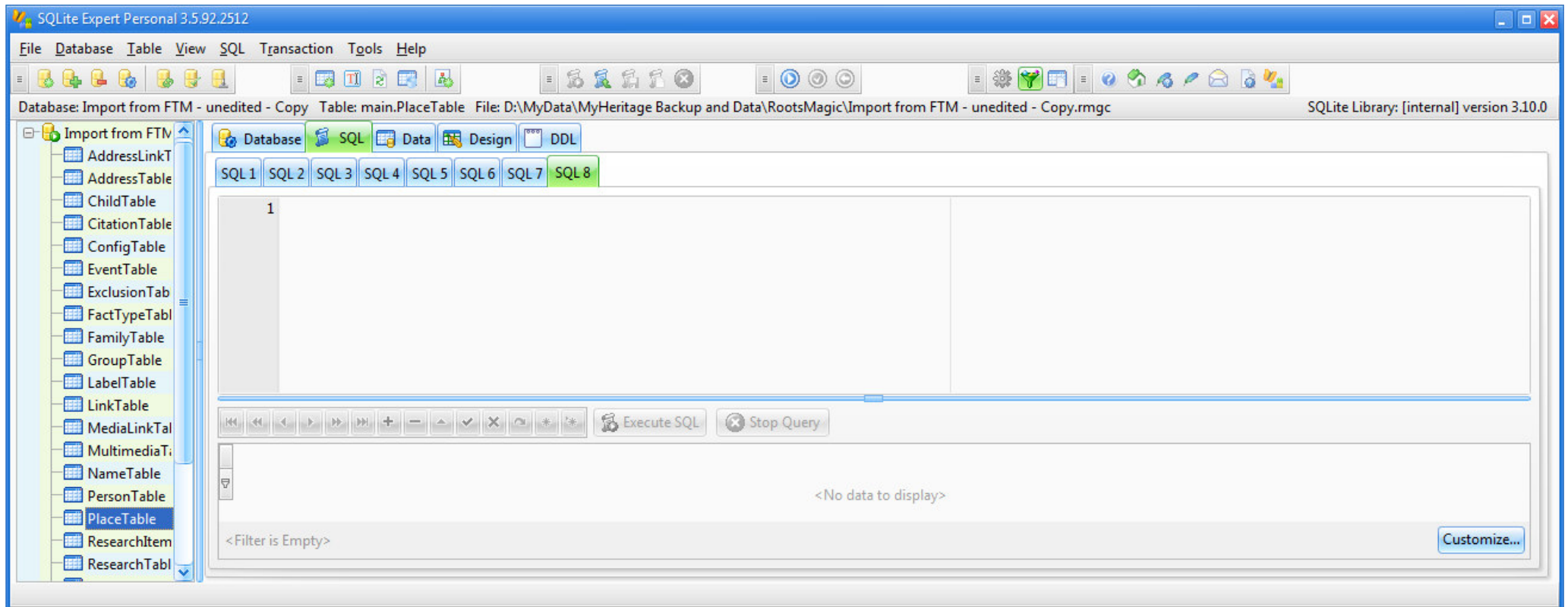

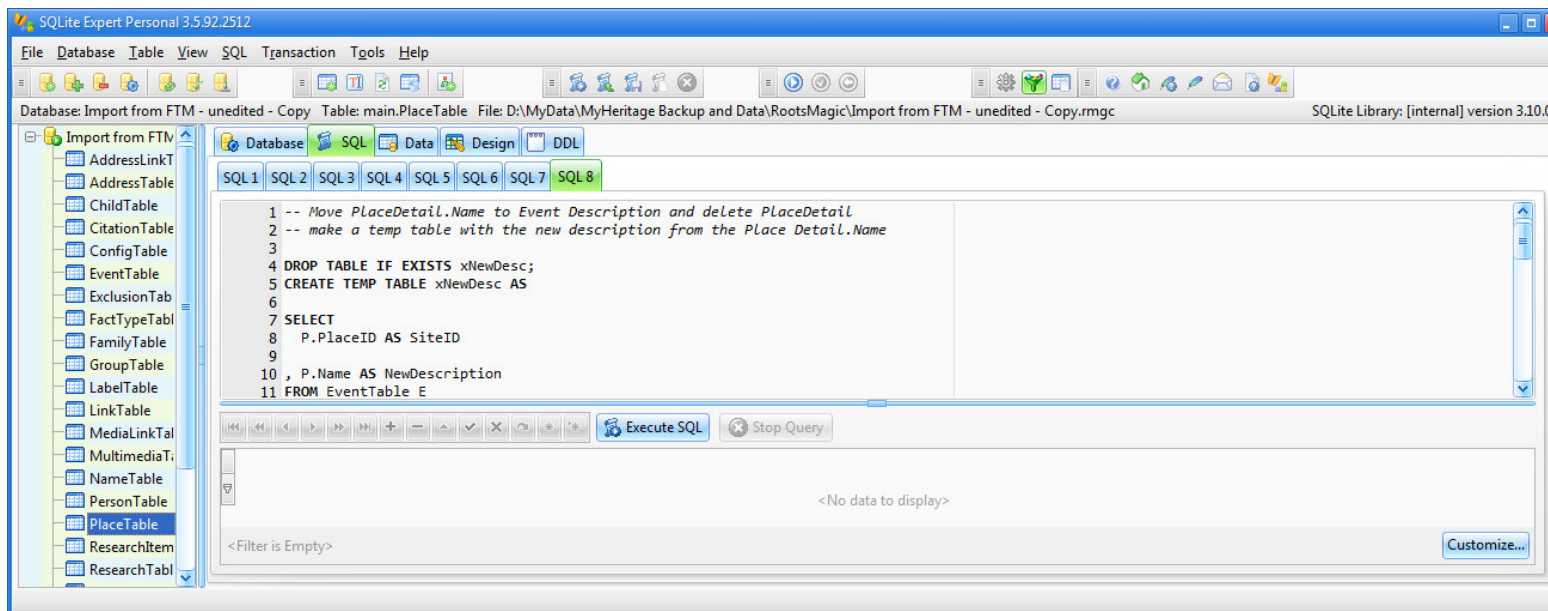
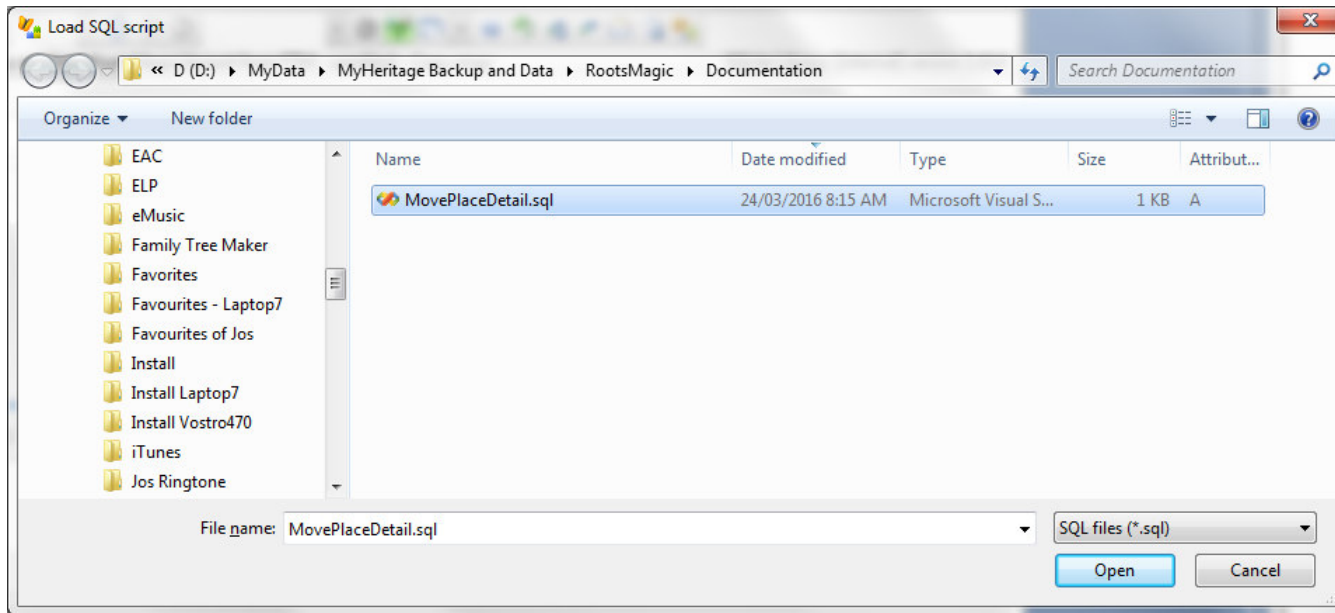
Place Details have the value 2 in the PlaceType column which you can sort or filter by clicking on the header.

Step 7 – Load the SQL

Goto the SQL tab. SQL > New SQL Tab. You will see an “empty” little SQL tab with a “1” in it.

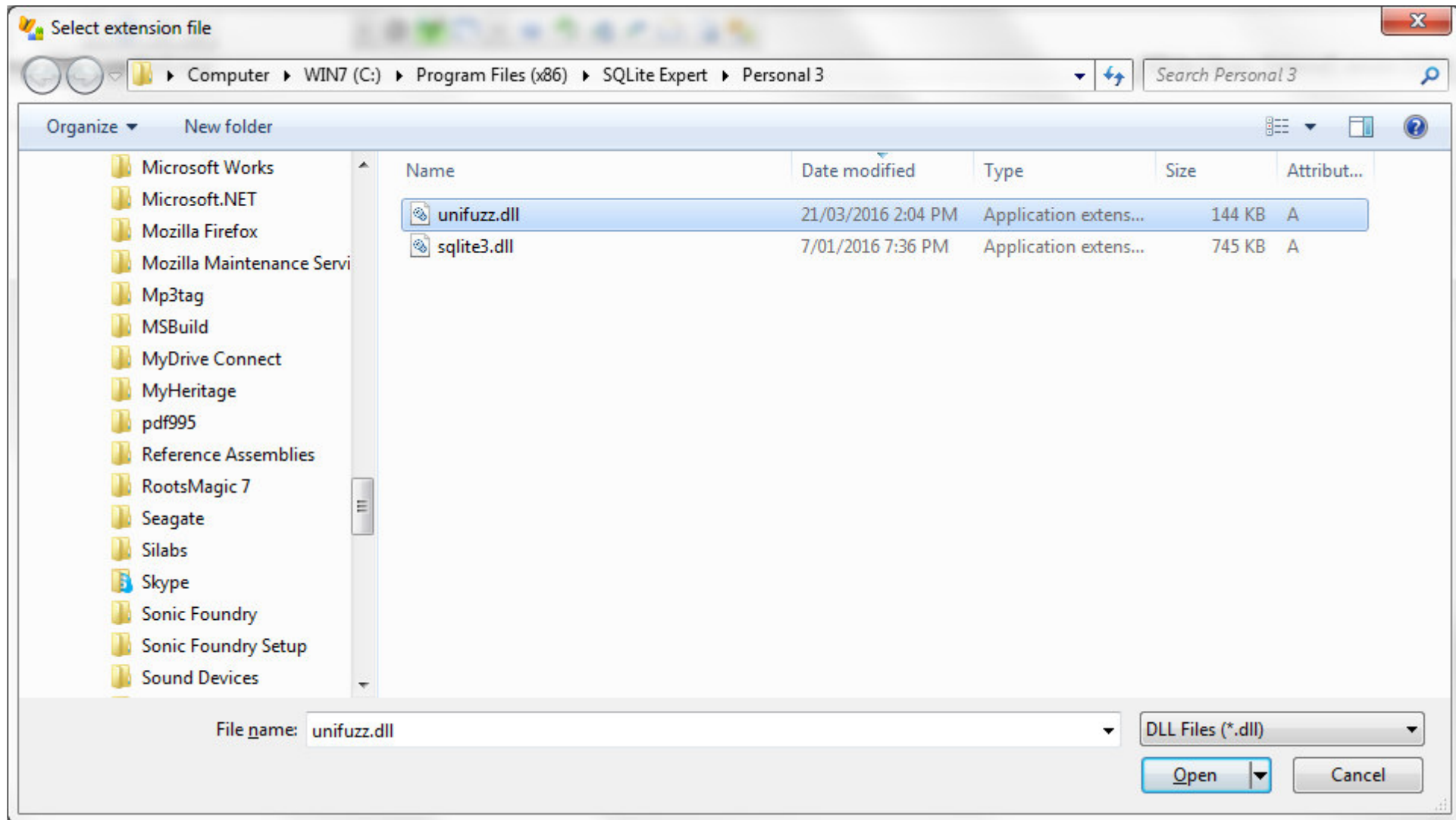


SQL > Load SQL Script



Step 8 – Load the extension

File > Load Extension. Choose unifuzz.dll.



Choose the default entry point when prompted: **sqlite3_extension_init**

Step 9 – Execute SQL

Click the button “Execute SQL”. Wait for the SQL to finish executing. The more data you have, the longer this will take.

Step 10 – Open the database in RM7 and look at the Description field

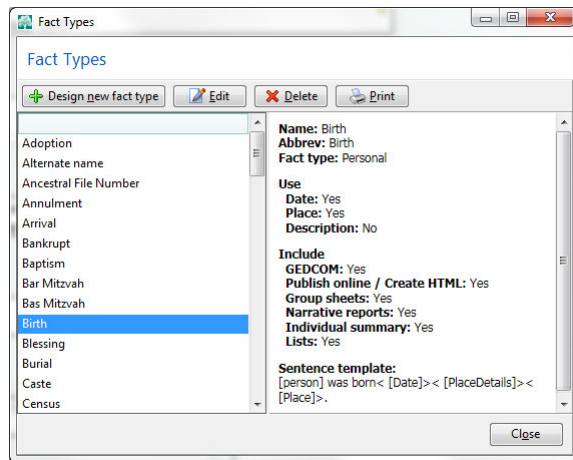

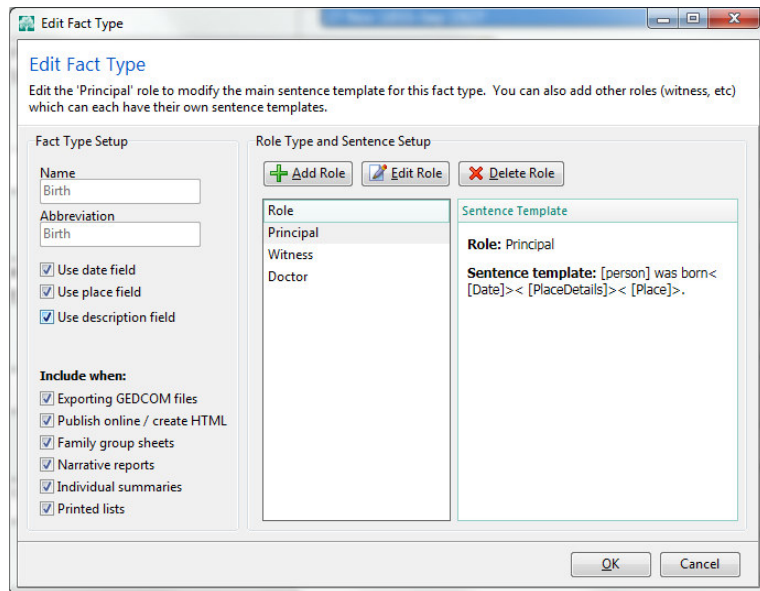
WARNING! You cannot see the Description for BIRTH. You have to enable Description for BIRTH, MARRIAGE etc

Step 11 – Enable Descriptions for specific fact types

You have to do this for EVERY RM database that you have! Lists > Fact Type List ...
