1. **John WOODS**¹ was born before 1788.² He died between 1835 and 1850 at the age of 47.¹ He was buried at New Bethel Cemetery (Presbyterian?) in Piney Flats, Sullivan County, Tennessee.¹ John has reference number 12.

John WOODS and Agnes -(w/John Woods) were married before 1808.²⁻³ **Agnes -(w/John Woods)**³ was born in 1778 in Virginia.⁴ Agnes Woods, age 72, appeared on the census in 1850 in Sullivan County, Tennessee in the household of her son, Levi WOODS.⁴ She was also known as Agnes Woods.³ She has reference number 13.

David WOODS and Jane ALEXANDER were married before 1830.^{1,5} **Jane ALEXANDER**⁶⁻⁷, daughter of John ALEXANDER and Martha FERGUSON, [PAR], was born on December 4, 1802.⁶⁻⁷ She was also known as Jennie Alexander.¹ She was also known as Jane Woods.¹ Jane has reference number 15.⁶⁻⁷

4. **Delilah WOODS**³ was born on January 22, 1817 in Sullivan County, Tennessee.^{3,8} She, age 23, is probably the female, age 20-30, who appeared on the census in 1840 in Carter County, Tennessee in the household of John ALEXANDER.⁹ She, 33, appeared on the census on September 9, 1850 in Carter County, Tennessee in the household of John "Elexander."¹⁰ Delilah, 43, appeared on the census on June 1, 1860 in Elizabethton, Carter County, Tennessee in the household of John ALEXANDER.¹¹ She died on November 25, 1879 in Marion, Smyth County, Virginia at the age of 62.¹²⁻¹³ She was buried at Round Hill Cemetery in Marion, Smyth County, Virginia.¹⁴⁻¹⁵ Delilah was also known as Delilah Alexander.¹² She has reference number 11.³

Delilah WOODS and John ALEXANDER were married on January 22, 1835 in Sullivan County, Tennessee.³ ceremony performed by Jesse Cross. **John ALEXANDER**⁶⁻⁷, son of John ALEXANDER and Martha FERGUSON, was born on October 11, 1812 in Washington County, Tennessee.^{6-7,16} He was born on October 12, 1812 in Washington County, Tennessee.³ He, age 18, is probably the male, age 15-20, who appeared on the census in 1830 in Washington County, Tennessee in the household of his father, John ALEXANDER.¹⁷ John appeared in the census in 1840 in Carter County, Tennessee.⁹ John Alexander

- 7 iii. **Eliza Jane ALEXANDER**³ was born on May 15, 1843 in Carter County, Tennessee.^{3,20} She, age 7, in school, appeared on the census on September 9, 1850 in Carter County, Tennessee in the household of John ALEXANDER.¹⁰ She, age 17, in school, appeared on the census on June 1, 1860 in Elizabethton, Carter County, Tennessee in the household of John ALEXANDER.¹¹ Eliza never married.¹ She died on November 23, 1869 at the age of 26.^{3,12} She was buried at Round Hill Cemetery in Marion, Smyth County, Virginia.²⁰ In memory of Eliza Jane daughter of John & Delilah Alexander born May 15, 1848 died Nov. 23, 1869.
